are all molars,  
which are replaced  
throughout the  
manatee's life.

Dugongs have  
incisors as well,  
and their teeth  
are not replaced.

Manatees can  
grow to be larger  
and heavier than  
dugongs.

Dugongs' skin is  
smoother than  
manatees' skin.
